## Opinion

We have audited the accompanying statement of quarterly and year to date standalone financial results of **Haryana Capfin Limited** (the "Company") for the quarter ended March 31, 2023 and for the year ended March 31, 2023 ("Statement"), attached herewith, being submitted by the Company pursuant to the requirement of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended (the "Listing Regulations").

These adjustments have been audited by us. Our opinion is not modified in respect of the above matter.
